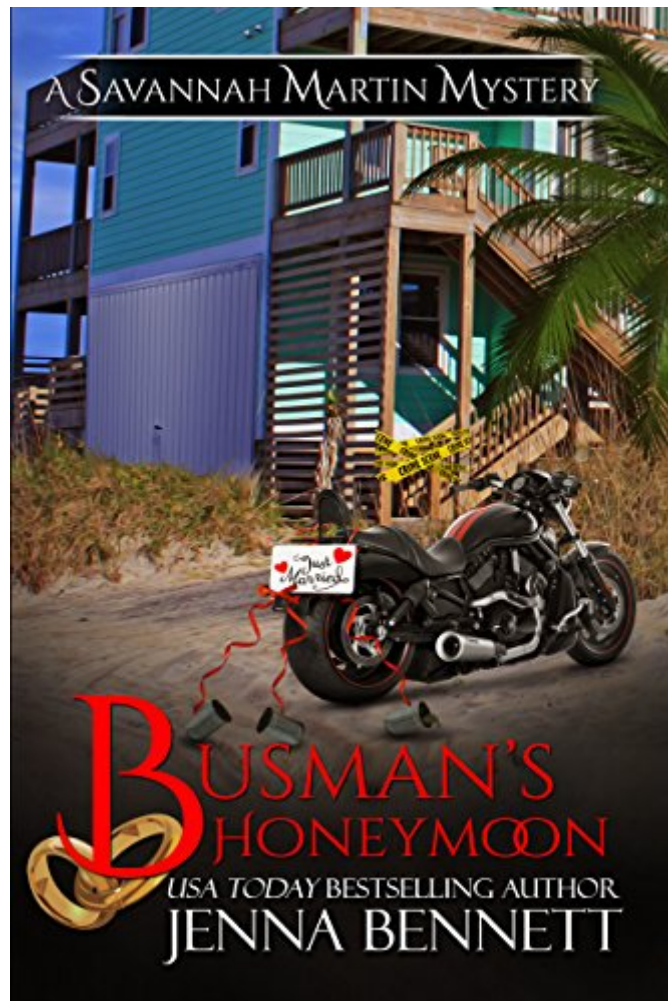


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Busman's Honeymoon: The Savannah Martin Honeymoon Novella (Savannah Martin Mysteries)

There is so much to love about the Savannah Martin series. The dry humor, the cast of characters, the jabs at prejudice and discrimination, the value of friends and family, and most of all, the tenderness, love and respect between Rafe and Savannah. It seems the entire series has been

leading up to this book, with the happy couple finally getting to their "I do's", before heading to a B&B honeymoon on the Florida coast, a gift from Savannah's sister and brother. But a B&B usually comes with breakfast, not a dead hostess. And when Rafe is taken in for questioning, Savannah begins her quest for the real killer, because she wants her groom to actually be part of the honeymoon, not sitting in a Florida jail.

You are invited to the wedding, an honeymoon, of our favorite couple. We have been in love with these two since the first book of the series and it is so fun watching them finally reach their dream. The wedding is amazing; it is an amazingly beautiful dream wedding and it is amazing that no one tries to stop the wedding. The honeymoon is exactly what you would expect; dead body, Savannah feels forced to investigate, and Rafe is under suspicion. Absolutely delightful. While there is a pattern to the story, the plot is satisfyingly unique. Need I say it? I LOVED this book (I know it is a novella but it feels like a book to me.)

This is a short read without any of the romance or romantic challenges of the prior books in this series. While I appreciate someone who likes manners, will someone please tell the author that it is ALSO rude to grill everyone you meet about things involving a murder. The heroine comes off as a busybody snoop that is always up in everyone else's business. Because the book is so very short, all this unwarranted questioning of others takes place immediately and all the time. Not sure I understand why a Southern Bell is so interested in solving crime, but that is part of the original premise, so it is fine. But my definition of politeness and good manners isn't the same as this Heroine's. Wouldn't bother reading this one.

First, I absolutely love the Savanna Martin series, but I felt this book was a little rushed. I missed the regular list of characters in these books. This one didn't have much of a story line. I'm sorry to say it was a big disappointment.

Finally Savannah Martin will marry Rafe Collier; life is perfect as they head to Florida for their honeymoon. Checking into a Bed and Breakfast late they haven't had a chance to meet their hostess, Frenetta Wallin. The next morning, when no breakfast is prepared, no coffee Rafe begins to see why the hostess is missing. You know that a mystery is forth coming when Frenetta is found murdered in her living quarters. Of course the local sheriff is sure that Rafe murdered Frenetta. So much for their romantic honeymoon instead Rafe and Savannah begin learning about the other

visitors to the B&B. While the story does keep you interested, it would have been nice to have a little less drama on their honeymoon and a nice story about Rafe & Savannah and the upcoming birth of their child.

I love this series so much that I actually read them three times...in a row. The characters are so well developed. One thing I really love is that Ms Bennett keeps bad boy Rafe Collier's character somewhat of a mystery-the only thing you really get from him is that he loves Savannah body and soul. Write faster, Ms. Bennett! I need more Savannah and Rafe!!!!

Savannah and Rafe are finally we'd in a beautiful setting at the Martin mansion. Catherine and Dix send them to a B & B in Florida for their honeymoon. Should be wonderful...right? Wrong!
