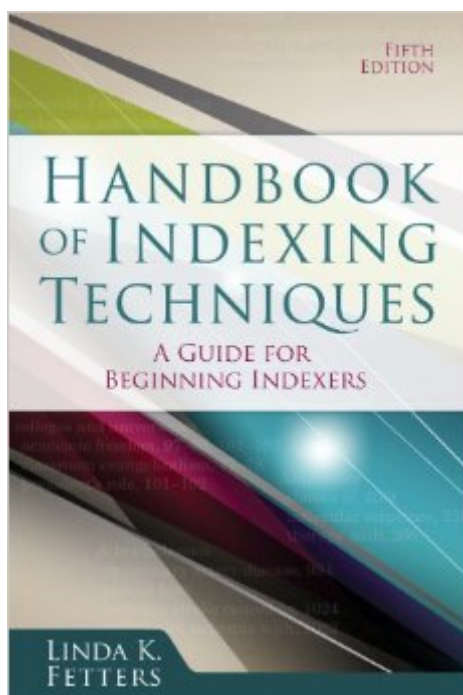

Much of the book is directed towards people who plan to make a career of indexing with information about software and training. She gives enough information about indexing the old fashioned way -- on index cards that I was able to create a good index. The author de-mystified the process and her examples helped me format it correctly.
