The storytelling was choppy. It didn't flow very well and some of the incidents seemed to come out of the blue. Needed better editing and maybe re-writing. The basic story was fine, it just didn't hang together very well.

I love the way Kennedy Chase writes, I can't get enough the books, I can't wait for the next book of the Hemlock series. I love the characters of the dog and cat, I love Grace and her family, I love witch books I am not into romantic books, this book just had a touch of that, and that is what I like. Not so sappy, intriguing, interesting, mysterious, and like I said witchy.....I won't go into details of the book, that is for you all to read, but I read it in a day or two or three.

Really enjoyed this. 3 sister witches living together and running a bakery. The youngest was formerly a police detective and the middle a baker, while the oldest was able to heal broken hearts. They try to keep a low profile in order to fit better and not scare the rest of the village with being witches, until a body was dumped on them. I enjoyed following the mystery, and seeing how they resolved their problems. Don't want to give away details, as it is so much fun to see it develop. Well written, and you start to get to know each of the sisters. Can't wait for the next story to know more about them. Lots of potential ! I also enjoyed that it is a complete story. Just want another one as this one was fun to read. I received an advance copy in exchange for my honest review, and did not let that influence me. If I didn't like it, I would say so, or not even review it !

I adored all of the Harley Hill mysteries by this author and I really enjoy this new adventure and new characters on this side of the pond. I found the characters to be well thought out, the story line fitting for an urban fantasy...all in all, an enjoyable read. I wouldn't look for any really deep philosophies, but there are some wonderful insights into behavior/human nature and some comedy/pretty awful puns, which I appreciate.. This was a quick and fun read...anyone who loves cozy mysteries should have a good time with this.

INTERESTING mystery. There are some editing errors though such as clearly letting us know Grace is 45 and later commenting "although I am well into my 50's". Or letting readers know it is just after Halloween yet it is December and Christmas is approaching. Dario is a nice touch and gives Grace who is a widow a charming romantic interest. The beach town in New England is well described and a corpse in a bakery oven is certainly unique.

Three sisters who are witches are trying to make a living running a bakery out of their home. One morning, a body turns up in the oven and they have to solve the murder quickly so they can get back into their kitchen. As the book progresses, the sisters discover there are other people with "extra" powers, some good, some evil. The characters are fun and quirky which I like. They don't always get things right along the way but everything turns out ok by the end.

I love anything magical and especially stories. I really enjoyed reading this mystery along with the characters. Mostly Noah and charity. Of course the witches and Warlock had a hand in the story. It was very entertaining so I thought it deserves a five star rating. If you like this particular genre, then read this book.

I have to admit I love stories that are located in quaint small towns. When the writer is capable of developing her characters with wit and intelligence it makes it a book with my time. This writer does more than allow the main character to solve the murder mystery. Our heroine solves problems, obtains a surprising love interest, and overcomes prejudiced attitudes amongst her neighbors. It is well and cleverly written, witty, and charming. I look forward to reading more by Kennedy Chase.
